An active member of the United Auto Workers, Sylvia took an avid interest in equality and justice for women, minorities, and union workers. She kept up with policy and reform issues and treasured her voting rights.

Sylvia always put family first. Her children and grandchildren were her pride and joy. She cherished every moment she could spend with them, including family dinners, holidays, and celebrations of academic and social achievements. She loved cooking and was excellent at it. Her home was also a point of pride and it was always immaculately clean. Sylvia's heart was always open to those she loved, and her smile was warm and her laughter was infectious.

She passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 18, 2020 with family in attendance at the Skld Nursing Home in

Bloomfield Hills, Michigan.

Sylvia is survived by her former husband Gaylord Kanoyton with whom she remained friends, their children: Gaylene Kanoyton, Lynne (son-in-law Jeffrey) Mills, Marlowe Kanoyton, and Nicole (spelling) Kanoyton.
