Ahmad Rahmere Terrell, son of David and Ralanda Terrell, was born on January 11, 1993 in Southfield, Michigan. Ahmad was a happy and friendly baby, which led him to becoming an outgoing adult. He received his education within the Southfield Public School system. It was during his time at Southfield High School that he began to develop his outgoing spirit and he evolved from a talkative child who was sometimes mischievous into a young man who realized how to use his voice for good. He found his gift in communications. He thrived while working in production and on-air at WSHJ 88.3FM, the high school station, until he graduated in 2011. Soon after, his love for communications began to take a more serious form in music.

In 2011, Ahmad, his younger brother Malik, and his close cousin Justin Bunkley united their musical talents and formed an entertainment group called DopeDiv, an acronym for Defeating Other People's Expectations Division, where Ahmad was affectionately known as Huey Fresmen. During this time, Ahmad also completed a broadcast certification from Specs Howard School of Broadcast in 2015.

Ahmad loved and cherished life and had a personality large enough to fill the four corners of any room. Ahmad's hero in life was his father; Ahmad wanted to be just like his dad. In addition to his appreciation of music, he shared with his father and brother a love for automobiles. Ahmad loved his father's classic

burgundy Lincoln, which is the inspiration for the color used for his physical eternity. He also loved his Mustang and was known to keep it in stellar condition. Additionally, Ahmad liked fashion. From his fitted hat and tennis shoe collection to his love for vintage clothes, Ahmad had a style all of his own and was the self-proclaimed, “freshest big guy since Biggie died.”

More than music, automobiles, and fashion, and above all, Ahmad loved his family. He looked after his family, especially his parents, grandparents, and siblings. Two of Ahmad’s proudest final moments were with the release of DopeDiv’s album titled, Coney Run and in learning that he was an uncle-to-be. Ahmad loved kids and eagerly anticipated the birth of his niece or nephew next year.
