Benjamin Fulton Jr., affectionately known as "June," was born on June 9, 1947, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He was the beloved son of the late Maudess Fulton White and the late Benjamin Fulton Sr.

Benjamin graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in Camden, New Jersey and soon after began his career as a Manager at Ford Motor Company's Delaware Valley Parts Distribution Center in Pennsauken, New Jersey. His dedication and leadership earned him advancement opportunities within the company, ultimately leading to a relocation with his family to Detroit, Michigan, where he worked at the National Parts Distribution Center in Livonia. Benjamin proudly served Ford Motor Company for 33 years.

Never one to rest, Benjamin continued working in his retirement years, initially as a security guard at Greektown Casino. Always eager to grow and for the love of gaming, he pursued a new path in his 60s by attending Gaming

School. He became proficient in a number of Table Games such as Poker, Baccarat, and Blackjack. He also worked at Motor City Casino and later MGM Casino, where he remained employed until his passing.

Ben was raised in the Union American Methodist Episcopal (UAME) Church and ten years ago, became a committed attendee of John Wesley AME Zion Church in Southfield, Michigan. He regularly attended the 7:30 a.m. worship experience and was steadfast in his spiritual journey of redemption.
