Clyde Barnes, affectionately known by his grandchildren as “Papa,” was born March 8, 1950 in Detroit, MI to the late Johnnie Barnes, Jr. and Annie Mae Barnes. Clyde was the fourth eldest sibling of twelve. His brother, Eugene Barnes preceded him in death.

Clyde graduated from Northwestern High School on June 21, 1968 with honors of excellence in Architectural Electrical Engineering.

Clyde was loved and respected by many and his presence will be greatly missed.
