April 24, 1932 - December 30, 2020

Dones Holmes was born in Winnfield, Louisiana on April 24, 1932 to Bertha McCain and Richard Holmes. He was the youngest of 2 sons. His older brother, Robert Ford, preceded him in death in 1984. In 1945, he moved to Detroit, Michigan with his mother. Dones completed his grade school education in the Detroit Public Schools and in which he graduated from Northwestern High School in 1950.

Dones was known as a serious-minded and business oriented young man. He always displayed a very disciplined demeanor which defined the kind of person he was throughout his life. Even though he chose not to be very social, he loved his family and grew to become the consummate provider.

On November 25, 1950, he married, Billie Jeans Grimes. They had one son, Richard Keith Holmes in 1952.

Dones joined the army where he found his niche. He remained an active as well as a civilian member throughout his working career. Later, he joined the Army Reserve unit where he earned the rank of Sergeant. He traveled extensively throughout his military career.

In 1954, while stationed at Fort Belvoir, Virginia, he met Betsy Dawkins. They married 7 years later on June 3, 1961 in her hometown of Alexandria, Virginia.

After their union, he and his bride moved and settled in Detroit, Michigan. In March of 1963, they had a daughter, Gail. In December of 1966, they had a son, Eric.

His lifetime career was at TACOM: United States Army-Tank Automotive and Command. In addition, as part of the Army and Navy Reserves, he accepted many assignments that stationed him in various parts of the United States to provide additional financial support for his young family. He was very dedicated to the military which remained the staple of his career until he retired in 1988. He loved to travel all his life. Retirement gave him the time and the opportunity for him and Betsy to visit many areas of the United States and abroad.

In July of 1973, Dones became a grandfather from his oldest son, Richard. Richard and his wife Kathy were in college at the time and needed some assistance with his grandson, Keith. Dones and Betsy graciously accepted the opportunity and pleasure of providing support and taking care of young Keith for a period of time. Years later, Richard and Kathy, had 2 more children, Seneca and Christiane.

Dones was lovingly known to his grandchildren as Zeke. He willingly fulfilled his purpose of providing and taking care of his family and he was ever-present. He was very active and involved in his grandchildren's lives from babysitting, providing transportation and various other ways of providing support. This was a role that he truly enjoyed. Even though he was a quiet man, you could tell from his actions that his family meant the world to him. He served as the "Rock" of the family---- the person that everyone depended on and you knew he would deliver. Even as his health began to decline, he always did as much as he could.

Dones peacefully made his transition at home surrounded by his family, on December 30.2020 after battling Alzheimer's.

He is survived by his wife, Betsy.

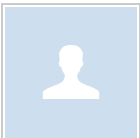
