Vertis Evander Dickens was born on September 7, 1930, in Atala County, Kosciusko, Mississippi. He was the fourth and youngest child of the late Lenora Terry Dickens and Alexander Richard Wilson Dickens. His brother Charles Alexander and sister Novella, both preceded him in death. Van as he was called by family and friends, untied with God at the Christian Liberty Missionary Baptist Church in Kosciusko, Mississippi. Van was educated in the Atala County Public School System and was a High School Graduate. Van migrated to Michigan seeking opportunity. Upon his arrival in Michigan he was drafted into the U.S. Army. He served his country in both the Army and the Army Reserves until 1959. After leaving the Army Van was hired by the Federal Government. At night he attended Cass Tech. where he learned advanced certifications in Heating, Cooling, and Electrical Engineering. He retired from the Government in 1986. After retirement Van enjoyed running his small business, gardening, traveling and spending time with his wife Carlyse, daughter, son-in-law, and family. Van met and married the love of his life, Carlyss Simmons Stokes in 1954. Carlyss proceeded him in death. To their union one daughter was born, Gwendolyn Dickens Frencher. Van leaves to cherish his memory, daughter Gwendolyn and husband Ronald Fletcher, nephew Melvin Johnson, Denise Dickens Sparks (Husband Melvin), Brenda Terry Millner, Jerlene Guyton Douglas, Bobbie Terry Adams, Franklin Adams, The Frencher family, and a host of family and friends.
