She had her primary and secondary education at Government Trade College, Aba, Abia, State, Nigeria in the 1970s. She became the Catering Manager of an international consortium that built the Yola Airport of the then-nascent Gongola State, Nigeria. Grace left Yola to further her education in the United States of America in 1981. She graduated with her Bachelor's Degree in Marketing from Southern Connecticut University in New Haven, Connecticut, USA in 1985. She thereafter worked for an automotive parts manufacturing company, ECHLIN, from 1985 to 1991. On May 10, 1991, she gave birth to her twin babies, Charles Chima Okwu and Charlene Chioma Okwu. Grace, a supremely, loving and dedicated mother henceforth gave her entire life to the raising of these twins.
