July 15, 1925 - December 6, 2020

Juliya Gabrielova, 95, of Oak Park, Michigan, passed away December 6, 2020, of natural causes after a long and full journey through time.

She was born on July 15, 1925 in Odessa, Ukraine. She and her sister, Raisa, survived the German

invasion of the Soviet Union during the Great Patriotic War. Shortly after the War, she met her soon-to be husband, Peter Gabrielova, a highly-decorated major in the Soviet Army. They were married in Odessa

but Army life eventually took them to Kazakhstan where Juliya taught mathematics and physics. After

Peter retired, they settled in Minsk, Belarus with their children, Igor and Dina.

In 1991, Juliya and Peter

immigrated to the United States, settling initially in San Francisco, California,

and in 2004, relocating to

Oak Park, Michigan.

Juliya is survived by her son, Igor Gabrielova of Glenview, Illinois, and her daughter, Dina Hatfield of

Cibolo, Texas. She is also survived by her two granddaughters, Vlada and Zhanna, and her two

grandsons, Oleg and Dennis. Her loving husband, Peter, passed away in 2008.

Juliya was an avid and voracious reader and loved vintage movies of all

genres. She loved her family more than life itself and was an incredible mother, grandmother, wife and friend to many. Sadly, her body wore out before her spirit did and she will be missed in so many, many ways.

She was a woman of greatness. Now that she left this world for another, she's still there in me. I always ask myself what would grandma say if I did this or that.

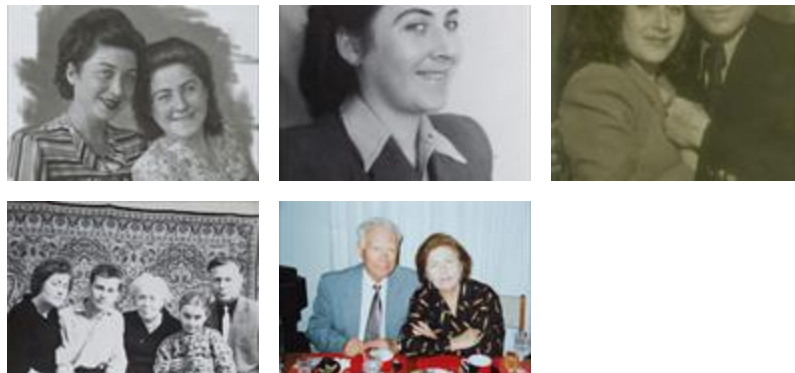
I will greatly miss her, but I don't say "Goodbye"!
