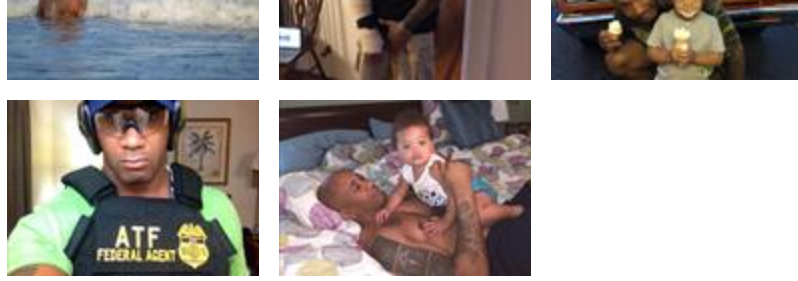
“ Mike was more than a best friend. He was there for me through my roughest times without hesitation and had a way of making you feel more loved than you ever imagined you could.
