Myrtle Lois Pender of Farmington Hills, age 97; made her transition on September 29, 2021. Born in Beloit, Alabama, one of 15 siblings all of whom preceded her in death. Though she cherished life on the large Gilford farm, she and late husband William Ralph Pender joined the Great Migration to Detroit in 1945 where they raised their two children, Mildred Carolyn Matlock and William "Billy" Ralph, II. Myrtle briefly pursued a nursing degree, but following years as an active homemaker dedicated to raising her children and serving her church (Vernon Chapel-Detroit AME), she became a teacher's aide, devoted to enriching the lives of severely developmentally disabled children before retiring in 1984. During retirement Myrtle enrolled in calligraphy classes, soon using her talents to the delight of family and friends who saved her greeting cards with beautifully scripted personal notes for years. Just as cherished but quickly devoured were the dozens of elaborate Christmas cookies for which she was renowned among family and friends across the country. Myrtle also was a basketball enthusiast remaining a steadfast Detroit Pistons fan whether they were champions or "re-building." Myrtle was the matriarch for numerous nieces and nephews and the spiritual
