I didn't speak English at all, but I managed to do well in her class because she always rewarded us with treats for our hard work. I excelled and was promoted to the next grade halfway through the year. I'm pretty certain that she played a crucial role in ensuring this happened and arranged all the ESL classes for me to help with my transition as I had to restart my education. I have fond memories of the song she used to play every morning as we entered her classroom. "Don't Worry, Be Happy" was the tune that always welcomed us. In fifth grade, I even helped play the song for her class. I was so committed to becoming her future teacher that I gave up my role as captain of the safety patrol just to assist her before and after school. It's hard to fully express how amazing of an educator she was and the profound impact she had on her students. It speaks volumes to see your favorite influential elementary school teacher being chosen by other students from Fleming at the DPS Superintendent banquet, where they honor the top graduating seniors and an educator as their guest alongside their parents. I felt truly blessed at that moment to have my first grade teacher and my high school coach to celebrate my educational achievements. I guess, "Mr. GOOD-BAR" helped me keep a straight and narrow path 😊 It was truly an honor having her at my wedding celebration. She was the only educator that took the time to pronounce my whole entire name correctly and the only one other than my father, that called me Clare Beverly.
