“ My dear friend Pam Pam,  
I remember when I first met you, you were my student at VIS, very quiet and using a walker. You faced so many obstacles: limited vision, recovering from a stroke, difficulties with mobility and the biggest problem, METROLIFT! MetroLift would be late picking you up or even not picking you up at all and your sister, Shirley, would have to transport you. Even though you had all of these things to deal with, you never gave up. One of the memories that I treasure and is an example of your tenacity and strength. You came into the kitchen and calmly stated that you prepared dinner over the weekend. I could not believe it, I had to prepare myself a cup of coffee, sit down and listen to your story of preparing a meal. This may sound like nothing but Pam and I had just begun talking about kitchen safety and she had not even cooked a dish during class. Pam stated that she was hungry and decided to cook spaghetti and she did it safely and her family ate the meal and it was delicious! I was so proud of her and I knew from that point on that Pam would not allow anything to stop her from achieving her goals.



When Pam graduated from VIS, she had stopped using a walker and support cane and only used the long, white cane that is used by persons who are visually impaired or blind; this is another example of Pam working hard and not giving up. Pam began volunteering at VIS as soon as she graduated from the program. From the very beginning, Pam had been an asset to the students and staff. She always had an encouraging word for all of us and always had a smile on her face. Even though I could not see her smile, I could feel it through her voice. Pam would always downplay her contributions to VIS but she was one of our greatest assets. I was always asking her to speak to students about her experience with completing the program, dealing with diabetes, eating correctly and being on dialysis; the students and I learned a lot from her. Pam was such an integral part of VIS and she would do whatever was needed to keep the office running smoothly, from answering the

*telephone, washing dishes , talking to me and encouraging me when I was tired or stressed and knowing when a cookie or a piece of candy would make everything better (smile).*

*Even though Pam and I were co-workers, she became one of my best friends. I have so many fond memories and I am so grateful to have these to lean on when things get rough. I remember going to the movies, going to the RenCen and you thinking that we were in Canada (LOL), our overnight shopping trip, your choir's Fall concert and attending the MAER conferences. Everytime I hear "Jingle Bells", (animated version), I will think of you and laugh uncontrollably. I will miss being able to pick up the telephone and talk to you and knowing that whatever I was going through, you would always be there for me. You had a love for people, your family but especially God. You would tell me what God would want me to do and how God would always be there for me and direct my path as long as I put Him first in my life, pray and ask for direction and strength. So, I am asking God to give me the strength to go through this loss and to also thank God for placing Pam in my life. I receive comfort in knowing that Pam is with God and resting in His arms.*

“ I met Pam when she entered the Visually Impaired Services program as a student. Learning she was a fellow preacher’s daughter, appreciating that connection we shared, I had no idea at that time what an impact she would have on our department, on my life. She was one of the most determined students I had as a mobility instructor. Having suffered a stroke and entering the program with a walker to get across the room, she stated from the beginning that she would get rid of the walker soon. True to her word, she worked diligently during mobility lessons to increase her strength and endurance, and sure enough, she was no longer using the walker when she graduated from our program.



That was just the tip of the iceberg when it came to Pam’s determination. She decided way before she graduated, that instead of going home and waiting for her next step toward employment, she would volunteer in our department while she worked toward her other goals. Pam maintained her determination and kept meeting with her state counselor, moving from Independent Living to a vocational program, all while continuing to put in the same hours (3 days per week) as a volunteer as she had as a student. Not to mention all that time, she had to receive dialysis treatments 3 days a week, plus actively participating in her church as a member of the choir. Any time she was able, she worked, and showed love and compassion toward everyone around her.

Pam made herself available for any work that needed to be done, in every place she went. She truly bloomed where she was planted and became a hero to me and others. As a student, volunteer, and most importantly, as my friend, Pam never ceased to amaze and impress me. She was an incredible human being with the Spirit of God evident in her life and personality.

This world is not the same without Pam, but it’s surely better because of her life. I pray peace and comfort to her family and

*friends, as this loss is heavy. I am comforted to know that she surely is in the presence of her Lord, Whom she loved and served all her life.*
