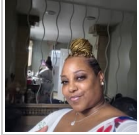
Death comes not as an enemy to those that love our savior and when it comes to his Saints, to be absent from the body is to be present with our Heavenly Father.

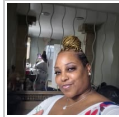
