“ I've had the pleasure of working with Sandra since the fall of 2015, at Pontiac Academy for Excellence. Sandra had excellent classroom management skills and always tried to prepare her students for life after high school. She wanted them to behave in a manner that would allow them to be successful. She did not tolerate cursing or other forms of offensive language in her classroom. She always described her self as being direct and consistent, which is a great way to describe her.

Sandra and I co-caught her Business Math class together. I would work with the Special Education students in her classroom. This provided us with time to talk with one another everyday. Talking with Sandra was one of the highlights of my day. She had a tremendous zest for life and a deep love of family. She wasn't afraid to speak her mind and she provided me with more laughs than anyone I've ever known. She was so clever and witty in her interactions with students. If a student gave her sarcasm, she gave sarcasm right back to them. Students would always try to ask questions or turn in assignments while Sandra and I would be in the hall for hall duty. Students would be transitioning from one class to another and when a student would interrupt a conversation she was having, or just randomly try to hand her something, she'd respond by saying "I'm so sorry but you'll have to wait until class starts, since I'm not teaching class in the hallway today, I apologize."

The staff and students at Pontiac Academy for Excellence were always appreciative of Sandra's efforts in helping with school events. She always helped with the organization of the senior prom. In addition, students looked forward to the annual trip to the North American International Auto Show, which she would organize each year. The students knew that if you were lucky enough to be chosen by Ms. Delaine to go to the auto show, you must be doing what you're supposed to be doing. She refused to allow anyone to embarrass her or our school, while in a public place.

I consider myself to be so fortunate to have had Sandra as a co-worker and as a friend. Her passing has left a void in the hearts of all that she touched. I'd like to send my sincere condolences to her family. I'd also like to thank them for sharing their beloved Sandra

with the rest of us. I'll cherish the memories that I have of her, for the rest of my life. If it is true that laughter adds years to your life, then Sandra has added years to mine.
