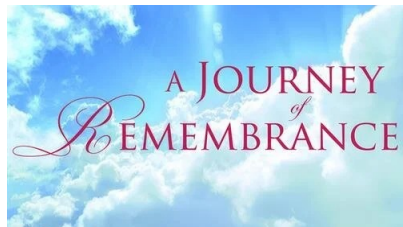
*What will matter is not what your brother, father, uncle bought,
